What is Exploratory Specialization Program?

Ans: Exploratory Specialization Program differs from a list-based course selection model by restructuring courses in modules. Each module includes about 4 to 5 courses, totaling approximately 8 to 15 credits. The goal is to guide students in exploring or learning across disciplines, building a more solid and diverse learning capability to lay the foundation for career development. Upon completion, the Specialization Program name will be noted on the degree certificate.



What is the course structure for Exploratory Specialization Program?

Ans: Courses are clearly related and hierarchical, organized around foundational, advanced, practical, and integrative modules, resulting in a well-defined learning pathway and coherent course progression.

Who can take the Exploratory Specialization Program?

Ans: The Exploratory Specialization Program is, in principle, open to students from other departments within the Daytime Bachelor's Degree Program.



When will the Exploratory Specialization Program be launched?

Ans: Exploratory Specialization Program is officially launched in fall semester, 2025.

How to select courses?

Ans: Course module information from each department is centrally announced by the Office of Academic Affairs. Students can enroll directly through the course selection system without applying.

Do I need to apply in advance to take the Exploratory Specialization Program?

Ans: No application is needed.

I have completed courses that are included in the **Exploratory Specialization Program. Do the courses count?** Ans: Yes.

How can I prove that I have taken courses in Exploratory Specialization Program?

Ans: Upon passing the required **courses** and completing the review process, the Specialization Program name will be noted on the degree certificate at the time of graduation.

What should I do if I can't complete the Exploratory Specialization Program modules before graduation? Ans: As graduation approaches, if the Exploratory Specialization Program modules are not completed, the Specialization Program name will not be noted on the degree certificate. However, any successfully completed courses may still be counted toward the following categories :
